

## Travel from Frankfurt-Hahn Airport (HHN) to Hilton Mainz:

### By bus/shuttle:

- There are direct bus services from Frankfurt–Hahn to Mainz. The journey takes around 1 hour to 1 hour 15 minutes. [Rome2Rio+2CheckMyBus+2](#)
- Ticket prices start from around €17-19 for the route Hahn → Mainz. [Rome2Rio+1](#)
- After arriving in Mainz (for example at the central bus station or main train station), it is a short onward journey to the Hilton Mainz.

### By car/taxi:

- Driving from Hahn to Mainz takes roughly 56 minutes, depending on traffic. [Rome2Rio](#)
- For convenience, consider booking a private transfer in advance if arriving late or with a group.

## From Mainz Central Station (Mainz Hbf)

### By bus: Bus lines: 9, 54, 55, 58 or 68

- Board one of the above bus lines at **Mainz Hauptbahnhof**.
- Get off at “**Brückenplatz**” (or a nearby stop along the riverfront, depending on the line).
- From Brückenplatz, it is only a **1–2-minute walk** to the hotel.
- Total travel time: **around 9–12 minutes**, depending on the line and traffic.

### On foot:

- The Hilton Mainz is also easily reachable **on foot** from Mainz Hbf. The walk takes about **15–20 minutes** (≈ 1.4 km) through the city centre.
- Follow Bahnhofstraße → Schillerplatz → Rheinstraße until you reach **Hilton Mainz, Rheinstraße 68**, directly on the Rhine river.

### By Taxi

Taxis are available directly outside the station.

- Travel time: **around 5 minutes**
- Fare: **approximately €12–15**

## Where to Buy Tickets

Tickets for public transport in Mainz (Mainzer Mobilität) can be purchased via:

- **Mainzer Mobilität App/DB Navigator App** – Digital tickets on your smartphone
- **Ticket machines** at major stations and stops (RMV machines)
- **Onboard purchase** directly from the bus driver
- **Service centers**, such as the RMV Mobility Center at Schillerplatz
